CLINIC LENGTH

Recertification, Entry Level, and Upgrade Clinics run for a full day. Participants can expect to be in attendance for 8 hours.

MINIMUM AGE TO ATTEND

A participant must be a minimum of 14 years of age to enter the program.

WHAT DO WORKSHOP PARTICIPANTS RECEIVE?

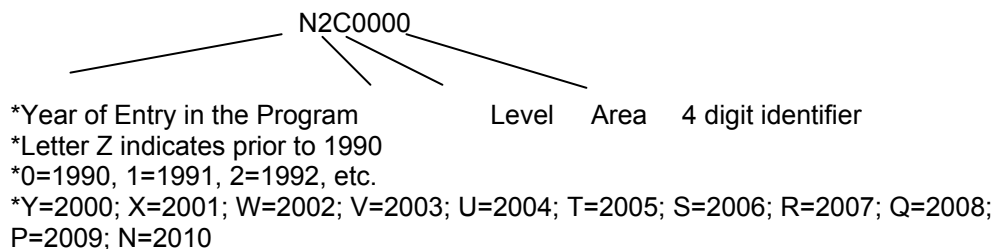
Participants successfully completing the Entry Level Workshop for new Officials will receive:
