

HOCKEY CANADA WRITTEN TRANSFERS

Letter of Approval

Per IIHF transfer regulations non-citizen players, men or women, under 18 years of age may be transferred by means of a letter of approval.* This form is to be used for American and Canadian minor age players playing hockey on Minor & Female teams. Written transfers are processed for one season only. There is no fee to process a written transfer.

Players should also provide proof of legal residency in Canada to their team. This information should be kept with the team registration materials.

After completing this form it should be fax or email to Hockey Canada Ottawa Office, once the transfer is approved by the old federation a copy will be sent to the new team as well as the respective Branch Executive Directors.
