SUBJECT: Sanctioning of Summer Hockey Programming

Ladies and Gentlemen:

It has come to our attention that some Branches are sanctioning summer hockey on-ice activities such as three on three events and on ice development sessions.

It is to the Branches discretion with respect to sanctioning these types of activities; however, it is important to be aware that if sanctioning and thus insuring these types of activities under the Hockey Canada Insurance Program all rules, policies and procedures that are in place in the winter must be adhered to. The premiums that we pay per player are based on the risk management steps that are taken within minor hockey and these steps are expected within any sanctioned activity regardless as to the time of year.

It is also important to note that all players playing within a Branch sanctioned summer event **MUST** be registered with the Branch and a premium paid on their behalf.

Finally, our members must realize that not all summer hockey is sanctioned by the Branch and thus by Hockey Canada. It is **VERY IMPORTANT** they check with the organizers of the activity they are involved with to ensure proper insurance coverage has been put in place.
